1. Snow Crocus (*Crocus tommasinianus* ‘Barr’s Purple’)
2. Grape hyacinths (*Muscari armeniacum*)
3. Heirloom daffodil (*Narcissus* ‘Van Sion’), N. ‘Thalia’, N. ‘Hawera’
4. Great Camas (*Camassia leichthlinii* ‘Blue Danube’)
5. Silver ponyfoot (*Dichondra* ‘Silver Falls’)
6. Sterile patented sweet alyssum (*Lobularia* ‘Lavender Stream’, ‘Snow Princess’)
7. Low native phlox: Creeping (*P. stolonifera*), Woodland (*P. divaricata*), Moss (*P. subulata*)
8. Stonecrop (*Sedum rupestre* ‘Angelina’)
9. Donkey tail spurge (*Euphorbia myrsinites*)
10. Golden groundsel (*Packera aurea*/*Senecio aureus*)
11. Golden dwarf sweet flag (*Acorus gramineus* ‘Ogon’)
12. Hairy alum root (*Heuchera villosa*/*H. macrorrhiza*/*H. villosa* var *villosa* ‘Autumn Bride’)
13. Allegheny spurge (*Pachysandra procumbens*)
14. Barrenwort aka Fairy Wings (*Epimedium* x *rubrum*, *E. x versicolor* ‘Sulphureum’)
15. Lenten rose (Brandywine strain of *Helleborus orientalis* hybrids)
16. Bigroot geranium (*Geranium macrorrhizum*) – ‘Bevans’, ‘Album’
17. Golden feverfew (*Tanacetum parthenium* ‘Aureum’)
18. Berggarten sage (*Salvia officinalis* ‘Berggarten’)
19. Calamint (*Calamintha nepeta* ssp. *nepetas* ‘Blue Cloud’)
20. Beard tongue (*Penstemon digitalis* ‘Husker Red’)
21. Bluestar (*Amsonia* ‘Blue Ice’, *A. tabernaemontana*, *A. hubrichtii*)

22. Variegated sweet iris (*Iris pallida* 'Aureovariegata'/'Zebra')
  23. Ghost fern (*Athyrium nipponicum* 'Ghost')
  24. Prairie dropseed (*Sporobolus heterolepis*)
  25. Palm sedge (*Carex muskingumensis* 'Oehme')
  26. Switchgrass (*Panicum virgatum* 'Shenandoah')
  27. Little bluestem (*Schizachyrium scoparium* 'The Blues')
  28. Mountain mint (*Pycnanthemum muticum*), Narrowleaf mountain mint (*P. tenuifolium*)
  29. Obedient Plant (*Physostegia virginiana*)
  30. Yucca filamentosa/flaccida 'Golden Sword'
  31. Slender deutzia (*Deutzia gracilis* 'Nikko'), Deutzia 'Chardonnay Pearls'
  32. Fragrant Sumac (*Rhus aromatica* 'Grow-Low')
  33. 'Tide Hill' Boxwood (*Buxus sinica* var. *insularis* 'Tide Hill')
  34. Summersweet (*Clethera alnifolia* 'Sixteen Candles')
  35. Spiraea thunbergii 'Ogon'. *S. japonica* 'Gold Mound'
  36. Red chokeberry (*Aronia arbutifolia*/*Photinia pyrifolia* 'Brilliantissima', Shadblow (*Amelanchier* x 'Autumn Brilliance')
  37. Spicebush (*Lindera benzoin*)
  38. Bottlebrush buckeye (*Aesculus parviflora*)
  39. Witch hazel (*Hamamelis* x *intermedia* 'Arnold Promise', *H. vernalis* 'Purpurea', *H. virginiana* 'Harvest Moon')
  40. Sweetbay magnolia (*Magnolia virginiana* 'Henry Hicks')
- Dogwoods: Grey dogwood (*Cornus racemosa*, now *Swidia racemosa*), *Cornus florida*
